our board meetings and conventions. If we have questions about past Federation activities or about the Federation by-laws, Carol knows the answers. Here is her spiritual story.

"In my twenties I was trying to decide which religion was right. One day while sitting in church, I heard a voice inside my head that said, 'Start with your own.' I attributed that voice to God and so I began to get seriously involved with Christianity. I really internalized it. And I taught Sunday School and also led Bible Study. My late husband, Stanley Hurd, had grown up in a family with theosophical ideas. One Sunday in 1967 my motherin-law invited us to a lecture at the Theosophical Society in Miami. It was on the topic of Reincarnation and it awakened something in me. I became consumed by the idea that if God was God, He must include everyone somehow. His message could not be limited to just those few who have experienced and were able to believe in Jesus. After a week I joined a class in Introductory Theosophy and then shortly became a member.

I feel, as do many others, that theosophy has become a way of life for me. It is really an extension of the Christianity that I knew, not a substitute for it. I am very grateful to all my theosophical teachers including Gertrude Sitt and Joy Mills, and also to H.P. Blavatsky and the Masters of the Wisdom for giving us the Teachings. I feel that it is my job to share, as well as I can, what has meant so much to me."
